



Effective Thursday, February 20th, there will be two additional driver's license codes in use in the application and endorsement screens. These new codes are TL & UL. In addition, there is a change to the existing XX license code.

TL should be used when an operator has a *Temporary Driver's License*.

UL should be used when an operator has an *Unverifiable Driver's License*.

XX should be used when an operator is *Not Licensed*.

Additional License Type Classifications:

MX: Mexico Driver's License, Consular ID Card (Matricula Consular), Cedula Identidad (foreign ID) or Passport from Mexico, Central or South America.

IT: Driver's License, CID or Passport from any other county.

UL: Drivers that show a "no hit" on their MVR, meaning the license could not be verified.

XX: Not Licensed, Expired license with no violations and/or accidents and driver cannot renew license due to no social security number; never licensed non-US citizen.

Out of State License: Use applicable state code dependent upon state that issued license
